- A basic knowledge of the physical, psychological and social effects of drugs and alcohol
- Identifying signs and symptoms
- Awareness of own attitudes to drug/alcohol use/misuse and how these may impact on your work with young people
- Able to recognise drug/alcohol misuse by young people
- Able to distinguish between drug/alcohol use and misuse
- Identifying current trends in relation to use and misuse
- Able to recognise emergency and risk situations relating to drug / alcohol misuse
- Aware of local specialist agencies and when and how to refer

Screening for Drug & Alcohol Misuse and Delivering Basic Drug & Alcohol Interventions. 1 day course.

- Knowledge of good practice in screening for drug/alcohol misuse & practice development in this area.
- Able to recognise and identify vulnerability in young people according to the groups listed by the Health Advisory Service
- An enhanced understanding of the range of age-appropriate interventions & support
- Greater understanding of roles and responsibilities in relation to interventions
- Able to deliver simple interventions (aware of sources of support e.g. FRANK)
- Access to useful resources and local support services
